FINAL REPORT CARDS

SECONDARY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

July 8th through August 1st — Grades 7 through 12

Registration will be held at the AHS Library on Wednesday, June 26th and Thursday, June 27th from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm (Payment by cash or debit/credit card)

High School Tuition: Residents \$200 per course and Non-Residents \$275 per course

Middle School Tuition: Residents \$350 per course and Non-Residents \$400 per course

The purpose of this program is to provide remediation for students who need academic support or to recover credits for graduation requirements. Students are only eligible to attend summer school if they receive a grade average ranging from 50-59 for the year. Because the coursework is concentrated, 100% attendance is mandatory. *Tuition is non-refundable.*
