MCAS TESTING

Sophomores (Class of 2022) will take the English Language Arts MCAS on March 24th and 25th. **School attendance on these days is crucial.** Make-up dates are minimal and prescribed by the state. All students must take and pass the ELA, Math, and Science MCAS tests in order to earn a high school diploma in Massachusetts. I recommend you discuss the behaviors below with your child regarding his/her responsibilities during MCAS testing which will invalidate a test.

- *duplicating any portion of the test or answer booklets (e.g., photocopying, copying)
- *accessing prohibited materials such as cell phones or other electronic devices (e.g., music players, game consoles, any device capable of taking photographs) for any purpose
- *communicating with other students (e.g., talking, whispering, writing notes)
- *looking at any other student's test or answer booklet
- *consulting notes, books, or instructional materials during testing
- *working in a session other than the one being administered, looking at questions or tests pages beyond the stop sign, or going back to a previous session
- *damaging test materials or removing any part of them from the testing room

Students should understand that test results may also be invalidated if they discuss the content of test booklets or their responses to questions with anyone, including teachers and there may be consequences if they do any of the activities listed above or otherwise violate test administration rules.
