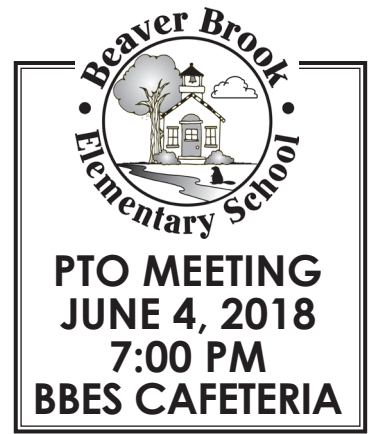


LEARN MORE ABOUT BEAVER BROOK'S PTO

CONSIDERING BECOMING A PART OF THE PTO BOARD?

PTO ROLES

CO-CHAIRS: There are 2 co-chair positions on the PTO board. The two co-chairs work together to moderate and facilitate the meeting.

TREASURER: The treasurer is responsible for making all deposits and writing all checks for the PTO. The treasurer should be familiar with Excel, but will work with the current treasurer to make the transition smooth. The treasurer also reports the numbers to the Treasurer of the Townwide PTO for tax purposes.

SECRETARY: The secretary is responsible for taking the meeting minutes and having them reviewed and approved by the board and the principal and the assistant principal. The secretary also creates the meeting agenda for each meeting.

You do not have to be on the board to have a voice! You can be a member by joining us at the meetings, voting on topics, sharing your ideas and volunteering at PTO sponsored events!
